BRANDING INTERN

Branding Interns support marketing initiatives and activities including campaigns, digital sales, content, and email marketing. Interns acquire fundamental business knowledge and skills while collaborating with a network of professionals. Students must be enrolled in a formal university undergraduate degree program and possess a high level of achievement including academic grades. Required skills include critical thinking and analysis, reliability, collaboration, adaptability, communication, and organization.

BUSINESS SYSTEMS INTERN

Partnering with internal and external customers, Business Systems Interns identify, evaluate, and develop systems, procedures, and practices that are streamlined to meet the business needs of the company. Qualifications include students pursuing a bachelor's degree with evidence of academic excellence, leadership, and initiative. Excellent verbal and written communication skills are required. Strong capabilities in critical thinking, analysis, organization, and creative problem solving are also required.
